- Lake Host Grant submitted on 3/7/23 – Award \$3230. 2022 – we had 2592 inspections, 114% local match, 2 ramps. This year’s match \$2500 from the town of Kingston in KCC budget. 3230 plus 2500 = 5730 for payroll to support Lake Hosts. Leigh Komonick will be the coordinator. Several lake hosts returning. Leigh will be at our April meeting
- Status on Watershed Grant through Camp Lincoln- Bell Environmentalists approved by Select Board to proceed with the Grant. 2 meetings postponed due to weather. Waiting for a new date in April for the steering committee to meet.
- Paddle Plunge Camp Lincoln Muriel is a judge. The Board approved \$500 towards Scholarship for needy children. April 15, 2023 at 10 AM
