New Business

- Tom O'Steen gave a brief update on the work of the Watershed Management Committee. There are 58 items identified in the Grant that need attention to improve water quality. Kingston's DPW has addressed all of the roads that needed improving. The Committee is also working on a 319 grant to improve the Greenwood Town Beach. Greenwood Beach is the number 1 site to be addressed to improve water quality. The need for education on stormwater run off was also addressed in the Grant. Lisa Perrault, admin for DPW, designed a handout about storm water runoff that will be included with the tax bills.
- Lake Host grant awarded for \$3300. Plus \$2500 from the town. \$300 from KLA pay to NH Lakes as part of the Grant award. Leigh is the coordinator and will be preparing the paperwork. Leigh has identified the 4 returning Lake Hosts, and she will be providing training. Lake Hosting will begin on Memorial Day weekend and weekends through to July 4, when they will be there during the week as well.
- KLA Newsletter ready to go. Data base of lake residents from Laura Diemer from the Grant will be used for the newsletter. There are over 300 folks around the lake. We will send out black and white copies. We will also include return envelopes for dues.
- May 17 State Park Clean Up. Tom Roughan with town highway department will help. We need volunteers.
- Shoreline clean up is on going.
- May 19 first water sampling with Bill Bixby and Linda Corson with Jim Edwards transporting to Concord. Thank you.
- May – September water sampling. Regatta July 27. Third Monday each month. Bill and Linda doing the sampling. Jim driving samples to Concord.
- June 25 KLA Community meeting. Tom O'Steen speaker, Chair of the Watershed Management Plan Committee.
- May 31 300th Anniversary of the Kingston Plains Cemetery. Tours at 10 and 1. Celebration at 12:00 on the Plains. In case of rain, Town Hall at 10:00. They need volunteers and there are lots of ways to help. Website:
