- Regatta update. There were 18 boats in the Regatta with a total of 22 people participating. Took in \$220. We picked up nine memberships making a total of 42 memberships. - Lake Host update. The Lake Host activity for July has been very busy. Total expenses to date \$2,785.88 to date. \$3, 317.44 remaining.
- Loon update – Loon Census conducted by Jim MacDougall and Muriel on July 19. Jim reported to LPC. Two adult loons and 2 chicks, born on June 30/July 1. Loon chicks appear to be thriving.
- Water Sampling is August 18 with Biologist visit. September 15.
- Tom reported from the WMP Committee. The 319 grants from NH DES will not be funded for 2026. The committee will meet at the Greenwood Beach Area to assess what can be accomplished with volunteer help. The Greenwood Town Beach was identified as the Number 1 site to be improved in the WMP for Kingston Lake.
